# Gain Access to MyICP and PSoC Documentation

You need a promoted account in Infineon's network to access My Infineon Collaboration Platform (MyICP), where the PSoC documentation is stored. The following steps will guide you how to create an account, get it promoted, and finally access PSoC Documentation:

#### 1. Create your Account:

Register with your company/university email address in Infineon's network <a href="www.Infineon.com">www.Infineon.com</a>. If a group of people needs to access MyICP, they all need to register separately unless they plan on using a single email address to access MyICP.

#### 2. Send Access Request:

Send an email to <a href="mailto:autopsoc@infineon.com">autopsoc@infineon.com</a>. Alternatively, you can contact <a href="mailto:Jasser.Rouis@infineon.com">Jasser.Rouis@infineon.com</a> or <a href="mailto:Lobna.Boussarsar@infineon.com">Lobna.Boussarsar@infineon.com</a> directly. In the email, mention the email address(es) that need access and which documentation you need access to, PSoC-Documentation in this case.

### 3. Promote your Account:

You will then get an email from Infineon. It will include some steps to 'promote' your account, e.g. adding your contact number in the system.

## 4. Gain Access:

Once your account has been promoted, you have to wait till an Infineon employee grants access to you to the PSoC-Documentation folder. You will be informed via email once access has been granted.

If you are from **Infineon**, you can skip steps 1-3 and simply send an email to <a href="mailto:autopsoc@infineon.com">autopsoc@infineon.com</a> with an access request.

<u>External customers need an NDA to get access to PSoC</u>. If you do not already have an NDA with us, the team at <u>autopsoc@infineon.com</u> will request an NDA for your company.
